Site Plan Must Include the Following:

1. Location Map
2. Property Lines
3. Location of all buildings, structures, roads or existing cut or fill slopes within thirty feet on either side of the property lines.
4. Topographical map showing area to be harvested and the location of forest haul roads, skid trails, landings and stream crossings.
5. A description of the proposed harvest operation, including a description of the type of harvesting, i.e., clear-cutting, diameter limit cutting (in which case, the minimum stump diameter shall be stated), thinning, selective cutting, etc., certified to by a professional forester to be in accordance with normal and accepted forest management practices. The plan submitted shall set forth how the applicant shall comply with the New York State Timber Harvesting Guidelines and how applicant will control the erosion or sedimentation that may result from the harvesting.
6. Detailed plans of all drainage devices, walls, dams or other erosion control devices to be constructed in connection with, or as part of, the proposed work.
