

1. In order to minimize facility impact, there is a (6) person limit per site. Visitors must register in the park office and are subject to fees and must leave the park by 10:00pm. There is no more than two (2) vehicles per site.
2. Only one (1) RV is permitted per site. No tents are allowed on RV sites without park manager approval. Factory installed RV air condition only, all other air conditioning is prohibited.
3. One extra refrigerator is permitted. Refrigerators must be kept locked and placed in sheds for safety. Refrigerators can not exceed 2.5 amps in order to protect our electric service from overload. These refrigerators and any other appliances other than RV equipment can be prohibited at any time if power consumptions jeopardize electric service.
4. Lighting and electrical wires are not permitted on trees and bushes. It is limited only to trailers, fences, and walkways. Lighting must be confined to your site and not infringe on your neighbors.
5. Two party ownership for seasonal sites must be approved by management.
6. Pavilion and playground areas are off limits after 9:00pm unless organized park activities are in progress in those areas.
7. There is a 10:00pm curfew for children under 18 years of age. Children must be at their sites at that time unless accompanied by a parent.
8. No bike riding after dark.
9. Any alterations of your site must be approved by the Park Commission.
10. Do not dismantle or make any new fire rings. We are trying to lessen the environmental impact. Campfires must be sensible and safe.
11. Help us to maintain the aesthetics of the campground in a neat and sanitary condition.
12. Firearms (or weapons) fireworks, chainsaws, power tools, portable electric heaters and washing machines are not permitted in campground.
13. Pets are permitted but must be kept on a leash; even our friendly pets can be scared by strangers. Please clean up after your dog and keep from excessive barking - especially at night.
14. The construction of unsightly structures is prohibited.
15. No mini bikes, A.T.V.'s, electric cars and unlicensed motorized transportation vehicles.
16. When you leave your site for any period of time or retire for the evening, fires must be extinguished.
17. Take extra care not to injure any trees, deface or misuse the park facilities.
18. Insubordinate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in dismissal from the park and/or prosecution by the local authorities. **Quiet time will be observed between 11PM and 8AM.** Any and all noise is limited to your site at all times. Respect your neighbors.
19. Anything and everything you bring into your campsite must be taken with you when you leave.
20. Observe all posted speed limits and signs.
21. All site improvements with gravel or stone and flower bed landscaping, must remain on site when you depart as a customer. All decks, sheds, etc. must be removed.
22. Disposal of construction materials, appliances and items other than household garbage will be removed at an additional fee. Consult park office if you are in need of this service.
23. There will be no refunds.

***Any violation of the above rules and regulations will result in the termination of your privilege to camp in our park, without refund of any fees, by order of the Town Board of the Town of Fallsburg.
