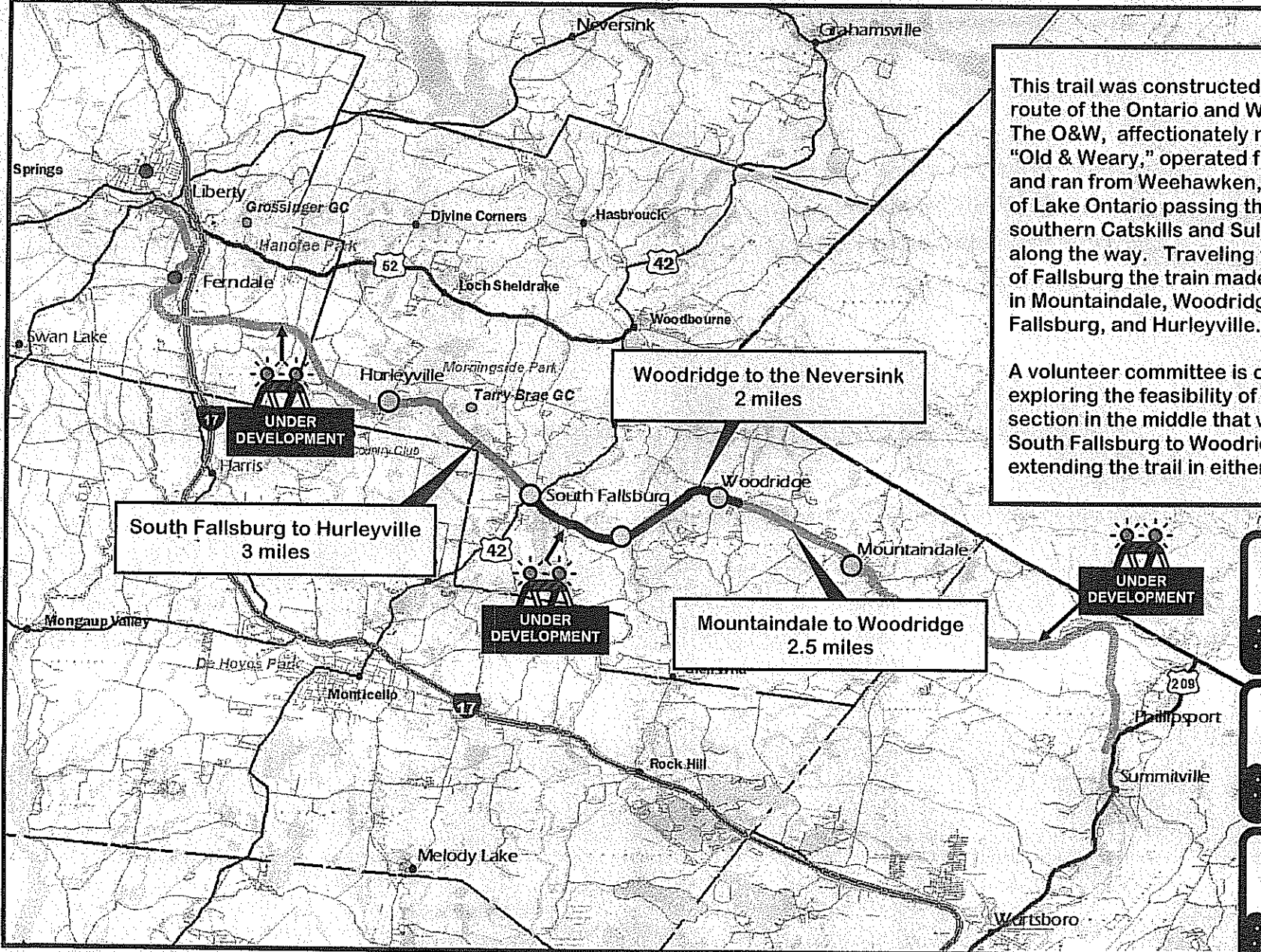




FALLSBURG O&W RAIL TRAIL



This trail was constructed along the former route of the Ontario and Western Railway. The O&W, affectionately nicknamed the "Old & Weary," operated from 1868 to 1957 and ran from Weehawken, NJ to the shores of Lake Ontario passing through the southern Catskills and Sullivan County along the way. Traveling through the Town of Fallsburg the train made stops at stations in Mountaintale, Woodridge, South Fallsburg, and Hurleyville.

A volunteer committee is currently exploring the feasibility of completing the section in the middle that would connect South Fallsburg to Woodridge, as well as extending the trail in either direction.
